Example 1

KSU Record Selection criteria

BIBLIOGRAPHIC DISPLAY not equal to "s" [record not suppressed]
AND BIBLIOGRAPHIC LOCATION not equal to "stark" [location not Stark]
AND BIBLIOGRAPHIC LOCATION not equal to "trumb" [location not Trumbull]
AND BIBLIOGRAPHIC LOCATION not equal to "mrntz" [location not Marantz]
AND BIBLIOGRAPHIC CAT DATE not equal to " - - " [fully cataloged]
AND (
(BIBLIOGRAPHIC MARC Tag 001 matches "[0-9]" [no alpha prefix in 001]
AND BIBLIOGRAPHIC MARC Tag 001 matches "[0-9]\$") [no alpha suffix in 001]
OR BIBLIOGRAPHIC MARC Tag 001 equal to "") [no 001 in record]
