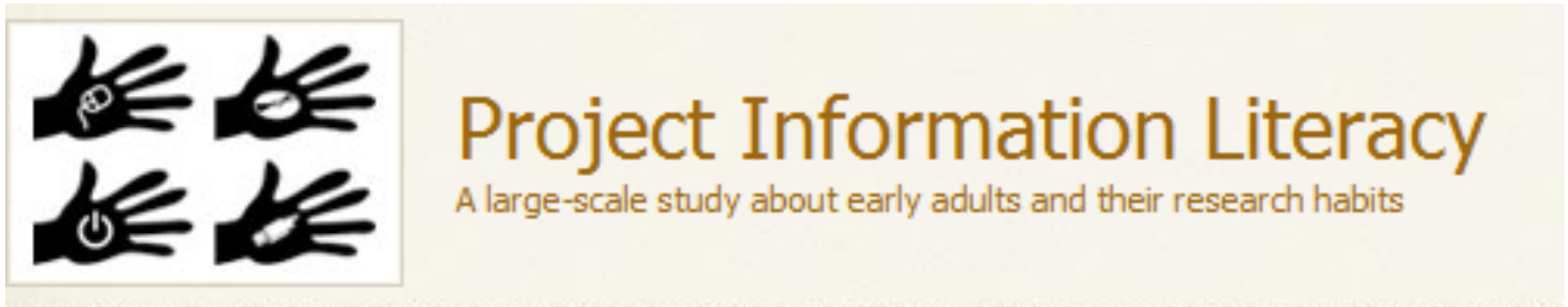
- We actively participate in and support the ODI initiative

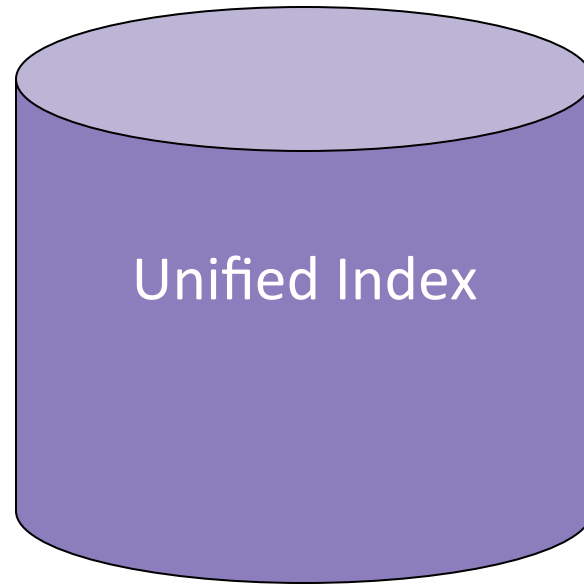

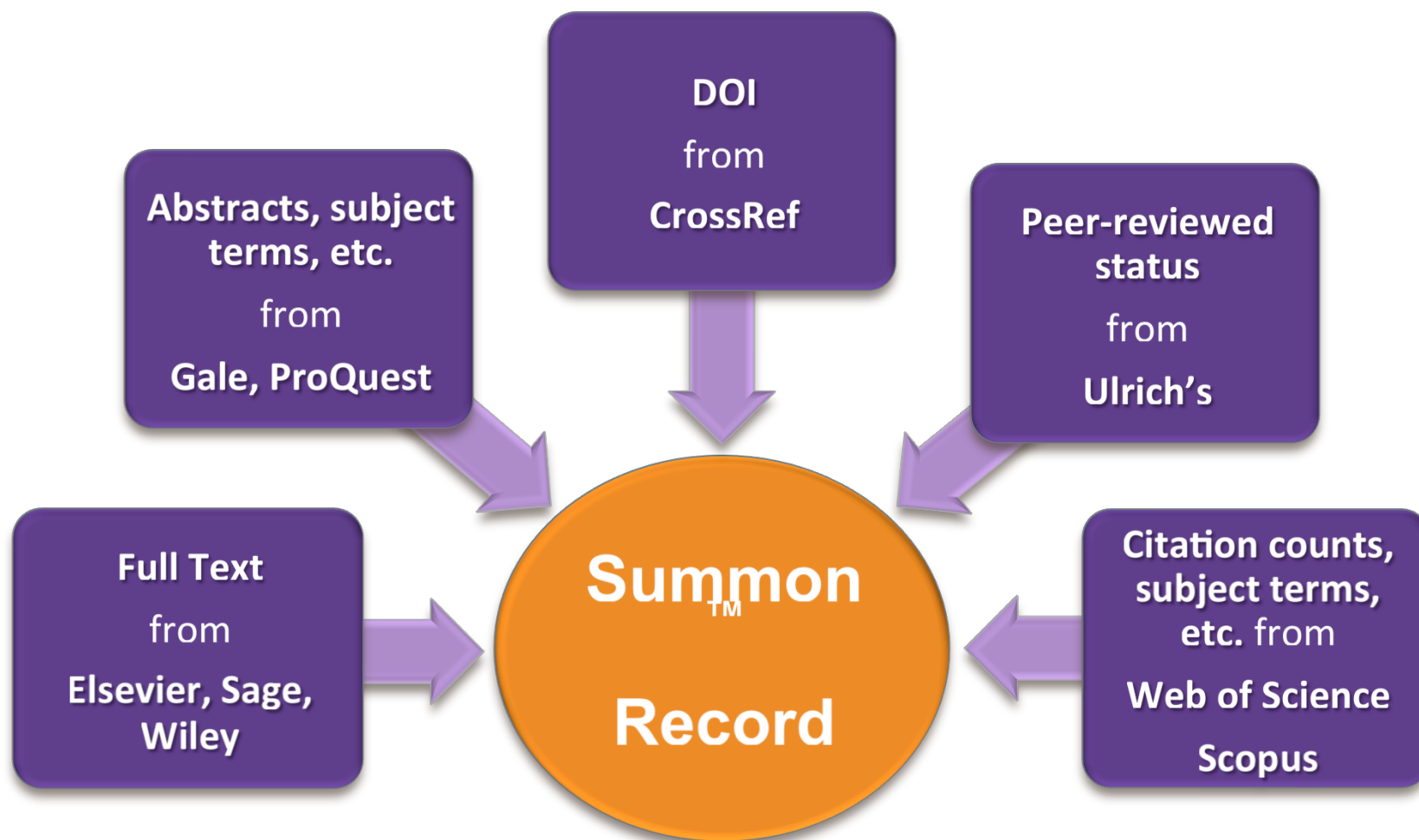
