Publication Cycle

--In the [Publication Cycle Google Sheet](#), the tasks highlighted in green need to be done this year. The other tasks listed are discontinued or will happen in later years.

--The main tasks this year are to finish the [Bibliography of Research Methods Texts](#) and add to the [Research Agenda Conversations](#) this fall, and to update the [5 Things You Should Read About](#) this spring.

The Bibliography of Research Methods Texts

--The Bibliography is revised every 3 years. The committee started working on it last year. In the Research Methods Bibliography shared folder are docs with the information gathered so far.

--Two people worked on each of the bibliography's nine sections. Each section contains recommended texts with short annotations.

--For each section, committee members looked through existing books and annotations and decided what to delete or add.

--Most sections had recommendations written up, but the changes were not made or discussed.

--The current Bibliography is on a site separate from the IS site. It was felt that it should be incorporated into the IS site instead.

Research Agenda Conversations

--The conversations are an "opportunity for leading scholars in the field of Information Literacy to talk about their own research." The first interviews were done in January 2016. The committee needs to decide on who to interview next.

--The [Research Agenda Conversations Ideas](#) doc is where committee members can add their ideas for interviewees.

--In 2016, committee members ranked the names then a task force created the interview questions and sent them to the interviewees by email.

--The Conversations need to be completed and published by January. The draft has to be shared with the IS publications editor to get feedback so it needs to be ready by December.

--**The Ideas doc will be let open until the end of day by Monday, 9/11, for committee members to add possible interviewees.**

--**On Tuesday, 9/12, the chair will send out survey to members so they can choose which project to work on: the Bibliography or Conversations.**
