- “Accept RDA cataloging found in OCLC as any other standard level cataloging. Do not try to revise RDA records to AACR2.”
- topics mentioned:
 - \$e rda in the 040 field
 - relationship designators
 - [place of pub not identified] etc.
 - pages, volumes
 - lack of GMD, presence of 336/337/338

RDA copy in CLIO

- Oct. 7th 2010:
 - first RDA record copy cataloged Oct. 7th 2011
- June 23rd 2011:
 - 1100+ RDA records in CLIO
