Statement of Concern

From the first free modern public library opening in 1833 and the founding of the American Library Association in 1876, the library profession has traditionally been and continues to be driven by a singular group. All significant contributors to the invisible standardization of how social identities and the social and political forces of the 19th century played a fundamental role in the profession. Library institutions have historically failed historically marginalized communities through omission, neglect, and implicit approval of general norms. The lack of diversity within the American library field as well as egregious behaviors cemented in indifference and unwelcoming notions, have left inappropriate measures for diverse library personnel to have meaningful inclusion and witness institutional change.

I am excited to provide assistance in the continuous efforts of creating and implementing diverse, equitible, and inclusive endeavors. It will empower the library system to continue its vision of becoming a safe environment where the voices of Librarians, paraprofessionals, library patrons and non-users are included, heard, valued, and respected.
