Pay-Per-View Options at UNCG

- FirstSearch 83 titles (added in 2002)
- EBSCO 1644 titles (added in 2002)
- American Institute of Physics 16 (added in 2003)
- Ingenta 318 titles (added in 2003)
- Science Direct 882 titles (added in 2003)
- Wiley InterScience 340 titles (added 1/2004)
- OVID LWW 187 titles (added 7/2004)
- TOTAL 3470 titles



Criteria for Selection

- Do not own a subscription to the journal
- Have print but don't have access electronically (usually an up charge added to the pricing)
- Have access electronically through an aggregator, but there is an embargo on that title



Reasons to Provide Pay-Per-View

- More journal titles for your users
- More back files available
- Quicker access to journal articles
- Collection development tool
- More cost-effective for low use titles



Problems with Pay-Per-View

- Reduced budgetary predictability
- Potential for abuse
- Barriers to users



The Carolina Consortium

- For 2005, 38 schools participated in one or more of the following deals
 - Blackwell 714 titles
 - Springer 1164 titles
 - Wiley 300 titles



Effect on PPV at UNCG

- 75% overall drop in PPV for 2005
- Wiley titles
 - 667 Wiley pay-per-view articles ordered from non-subscribed titles in 2004
 - 93% of titles ordered through Wiley last year are now available through our consortia deal
 - 2004 we paid \$10155 in pay per view costs
 - 2005 we paid an extra \$2754 to receive 250 Wiley titles via the Carolina Consortium – Average \$11.00 a title
- Wiley title American Journal of Medical Genetics, Parts A, B, and C
 - 2004 Subscription cost = \$9333 for ? uses
 - $-2004 \text{ PPV cost} = 64 \times \$10 = \$640 \text{ for } 64 \text{ uses}$
 - 2005 Consortium cost = \$11 for 221 uses



Where we are heading

- Budget problems
- Collection cuts
- 23% journal cuts
- May need to pull out of some big deals



Where we are heading

- Continue with American Institute Physics
- Continue with adding titles in FirstSearch that maybe canceled
- Continue with IngentaConnect
- Continue offering Science Direct PPV for older backfiles
- If we have to drop a big deal we will look into some type of pay per view option.
