Collecting Recitals at the Libraries

- Collection includes ensembles and faculty performances, as well as graduate, guest artist, and undergraduate recitals.
- Exist on reel-to-reel, cassette tapes, CDs, and most recently shared on Google Drive.
- Reason for collecting: part of university record, teaching value



Cataloguing Recitals*

Recitals generally arrive with an accompanying program and an overall listing for the season. If a seasonal listing document comes along with the recitals to be cataloged, use the document to annotate number of copies, number of multipart discs, or lack of copies received. This document should be returned to Special Collections along with the finished, cataloged recital discs and programs.

If available, catalog the recital from the accompanying program. The accompanying program may be attached to the disc case with a rubber band or brought in the box alongside the disc cases. If no program is available, catalog from the information on the disc and if possible bibliographic information can be ascertained from the back cover of the previous date's program. Sometimes an old program will come with the new season's arrivals. When this happens, go back to the old recital record on OCLC and fill in the details from the program.

Keep all programs together in order by date. Do not write on the programs. There is a basic record in ALMA for programs. When Yvonne receives the new season, she will update the holdings record for programs.

Below are the procedures for cataloging recitals:

1. In OCLC, create a sound recording record by Cataloging > Create > Single record > Sound recordings or CTRL+SHIFT+R.
2. Next, apply the online constant data record for Recital CD: Edit > Constant Data > Online > Apply from List > OK > Choose Recital CD. At the top of the screen, under Choose fields to apply, select Both, then click Apply Selected.
3. Reformat the record using CTRL+R or the reformat icon on the toolbar.
4. LDR is usually K. In general, we do not add full analytical added entries. If you decided to do full analysis, change the LDR to I.
5. Make sure you add a 500 title note. You may catalog from the accompanying program. If there is no program, catalog from the disc surface. You may also catalog from the seasonal listing document. See below for 500 formatting examples:

500::Title from accompanying program;

500::Title from disc surface;

500::Title from Academic year 2XXX-2XXX performance.

6. According to MLA best practices, encode a 1XX Main entry for the composer or corporate body only when it is clear that they are "responsible for the creation of, or contributing to the realization of, the intellectual or artistic content of a resource". Principle performers should not be listed in the 1XX field.
7. Principle performers CAN be listed in the statement of responsibility (245 \$c).
8. 246: Add when necessary.
9. 962:__: we continue to use the wording found in the constant data: Binghamton University Music Department tape recordings. Use this structure regardless of the format.
10. 505 contents notes are usually complete and unenhanced (no #t and #r) since ~2009. Historically, we have shortened contents notes to "Works of..." It is **up to the cataloger** whether to use "Works of", complete contents (unenhanced), partial contents (unenhanced), enhanced contents, enhanced partial contents or uncontrolled analytical added entries (740:02).
11. 518 field--Date, time and place of event are always added.
12. 650 fields are up to the cataloger. According to past practices, there is limited use of subjects if any.
13. 7XX for all performers and corporate bodies. Use relationship designators.
14. Check all names against the authority file in OCLC. If there is a conflict make use of the #c : Last Name, First Name #c (Soprano)
15. Check all names in ALMA. You will constantly adjust names to maintain uniformity in ALMA and OCLC. These names take precedence over other fields in the record, in order to establish access to important university figures.

Digitizing Recitals

- Funds from the *New York State Program for the Conservation and Preservation of Library Research Materials* to digitize the reel-to-reels
- Outsource digitization to George Blood LP



Digital Preservation at the Libraries

- Implemented Rosetta, a digital preservation system, from ExLibris, in 2011.
- One of the first academic libraries to implement Rosetta.
- Demonstrate that Rosetta could be scaled-down
- The plan: identify “low hanging fruit” to preserve - show proof of concept -get trust / interest of faculty - scale up digitization preservation efforts.
- All “good” until the person responsible for Rosetta and digital preservation left....





Add to Rosetta???

- Challenges
 - Rosetta
 - Little knowledge of audio preservation
 - No strategy or workflow for preserving audio recordings
- But we had .wav files!


