## History

- Officially opened September 5, 2019
- \$1.8 million renovation (including Makerspace and Multimedia)
- Original equipment included
  - o 7-3D printers
  - Laser cutter
  - Sewing machine
  - Vinyl Cutter
- Closed in March 2020 due to pandemic
  - Services only offered remotely for pickup
- Reopened Fall 2021







### The Idea

Foster a sense of community and well-being by creating a sense of belonging given the struggle to engage and connect with students since the start of the pandemic.



Increase variety of available equipment.

Support a broader range of interests and skills.

Reduce barriers of entry into the space.
