What libraries are eligible?

School libraries, public or private, that served children in grades K-8 and conducted humanities programs (e.g., social studies, poetry, art, music and foreign language) during the current (2015-16) school year can apply.

What does the winning library receive?

\$5,000, plus a plaque. Also, your winning library program will be publicized as a model for school libraries across the country.
