### **SUMMARY**

Every two years, the Core International Relations Committee evaluates candidates to serve as Core's representatives to IFLA committees and recommends a top candidate for each one. This information is then sent to the Core Board of Directors who are responsible for voting on it.

### **BACKGROUND**

Below are the Core International Relations Committee's recommendations for Core's representatives to various IFLA committee. We did not receive applicants for all of the committees with open positions; however, we found a qualified candidate for every committee in which there was at least one applicant. Candidates were evaluated in accordance with a rubric created by the committee. Unless otherwise noted, all nominated candidates received the highest score in their respective categories.
