Report of the liaison from Sears List of Subject Headings ALA Core Subject Analysis Committee (SAC) January 2023

The 23rd Edition of the Sears List of Subject Headings was published in October 2022. The price for the hardcover edition is \$195, which includes a year of online access. An annual subscription is \$195 for a single user. An informal advisory board included Lori Brennan, Todd M. Grooten, and Bryan Baldus, and additional feedback had been received from multiple librarians across the U.S. and Canada in the past four years.

Previous editions of Sears were published by H.W. Wilson (EBSCO) and edited by full-time/in-house staff. For the 23rd Edition, Grey House Publishing hired an editor only for a six-month period of editing; there is currently no acting editor of Sears to field questions or take suggestions.

The first edition of Sears was published in 1923, but no commemorations for the 100th anniversary are planned as far as I'm aware.
