Meetings

- The PCC Policy Committee Annual Meeting was held at the Library of Congress from November 2nd-3rd, 2023.

Advisory committees

• The <u>PCC RDA Communications Committee</u> has been set up as one of the primary mechanisms for communication between PCC members and standards creators on issues dealing with RDA and its surrounding documentation. We invite all to participate. If you have a comment—whether major or minor—about RDA, the Toolkit, the LC-PCC Policy Statements, the Metadata Guidance Documentation, or the official PCC RDA Training, including suggestions for improvement, corrections, etc., please use the <u>RDA</u> <u>Communications Committee Feedback Form</u>.

Decisions

- The PCC Policy Committee has decided that the PCC will have a rolling implementation from May 1, 2024 to April 30, 2027. This 3-year rolling implementation will allow institutions to from May 1, 2024 to April 30, 2027. This 3-year rolling implementation will allow institutions to transition to the official RDA Toolkit when they are ready before the removal of the original RDA Toolkit.
- <u>SCS Policy Recommendations on Non-Latin Script Cross-Reference Special Coding</u> <u>Practice in the LC/NACO Name Authority File</u> was revised and approved by PoCo on August 9. The PoCo has decided to delay implementation of the new Non-Latin reference practice, and to defer publishing the proposed revisions to the DCM Z1 and other documentation. August 15, 2023 will no longer be Day One.
- Survey on the Purpose of PCC OpCo Meeting was sent to the PCC community on July 6 and closed on August 21. It is to assess the needs and desires of the PCC community

regarding the traditional function and structure of the annual Operations Committee (OpCo) meeting. The survey results will be shared in the fall.

Task Groups

- The PCC Task Group to Test the Official RDA Toolkit was charged to conduct a thorough test of the Official RDA Toolkit to ensure that PCC catalogers can use the toolkit, related LC/PCC Policy Statements (LC-PCC PSs), and Metadata Guidance Documents (MGDs) to accurately catalog materials in various formats in both MARC and BIBFRAME. In particular, the test focused on ensuring that the PCC policy statements and metadata guidance documents work well in the new toolkit before it is implemented For additional information about the test, consult the <u>PCC RDA Test Documentation &</u> <u>Training Google Drive folder</u>.
- <u>Charge</u> for the PCC Advisory Committee on Equity, Diversity, Inclusion, Belonging, and Accessibility (EDIBA) was accepted
- <u>Charge</u> for the PCC RDA Implementation Task Group was accepted
- Charge for the PCC Consultation Group for Library Systems and Vendors was accepted.
