- Version 4 released in August2019
 - All of the functionality of version 3
 - Modern web navigation techniques
 - Runs on a wide range of devices

 - Navigation features do not work properly on Microsoft Explorer

Kyïv (Ukraine)

- Authorized access point changed in September 2019
 - Based on ALA/LC romanization table for Ukranian
- LCSH updated in December2019
- LCC updated in January 2020
- NAF revisions are ongoing

First-level
Administrative
Divisions of
France and
Norway

- LC has undertaken projects to revise access points for first-level administrative subdivisions
 - Based on BGN decisions
 - Will be accomplished systematically

LCSH "Multiple" Subdivisions

- "Multiple" subdivisions under – Religious aspects
 - Since June 2019
 - Created 2,471 authority records
 - Cancelled 294 authority records
 - Redesignated 75 validation records

LCSH "Multiple" Subdivisions

- Catalogers should
 - Always search LCSH
 - Do not assume that a multiple subdivision still exists
 - Propose new subdivisions as needed where a multiple does not exist [any longer]
 - Continue to use existing multiples as usual until they are cancelled (see SHM H 1090)

- Current practice
 - LCCNs appear in "Work cat." citations in authority records
 - In 670 \$a

- New practice
 - LCCNs appear in "Work cat." citations in authority records
 - In 670 \$w

670 ## \$a Work cat: Finding Julia, 2014: \$b p. 13 (Bollinger family) ... **\$w (DLC)2015300502**

- Applies to proposals for
 - LC subject headings
 - LC genre/form terms
 - LC medium of performance terms for music
 - LC demographic group terms
 - Moratorium on proposals

- Applies to
 - "Work cat." citations in proposals for new headings
 - New "Work cat." citations in proposals to revise existing records
 - Not to existing citations

- LCCN provided by
 - LC catalogers
 - SACO members making proposals for CIPs that are cataloged in the CIP Partnership Program

- Other bibliographic record control numbers
 - May be provided by SACO members, if desired
 - Local control number
 - Control number from bibliographic utility

- Format
 - Final subfield of 670 field
 - Provide only one subfield \$w per 670 field
 - Control number preceded by the MARC code for the agency to which the number applies, enclosed in parentheses

\$w (DLC)2020123456 \$w (OCoLC)198765401

- Updates made to
 - Documentation
 - Subject Headings Manual, draft genre/form, medium of performance, and demographic group term manuals
 - Proposal templates

- Anticipated timeline
 - February 2020: Subfield \$w used in proposals
 - April 2020: Subfield \$w
 appears in approved records

- Breaking-in period
 - PTCP will correct proposals that include LCCN in 670 \$a
- After breaking-in period
 - Proposals will be returned for correction before they are scheduled for a list
