BIBCO Music Funnel

Established in April 2015

- Complements the NACO Music Project and the SACO Music Funnel
- Will help develop PCC best practices for music cataloging

LC's BIBFRAME Pilot

Expected to begin in July 2015 and last at least three months

- Questions to be explored
 - Can catalogers input native BIBFRAME?
 - Is the BIBFRAME Work/Instance dichotomy clear and useful?
 - Do type-ahead and other "helpers" work?

LC's BIBFRAME Pilot

 Experimental database will be seeded
LC database of MARC bibliographic records
Title authority records reconfigured into BIBFRAME work descriptions

LC-PCC PS Updates

February 2015

Focused on aligning the PSs with the CONSER and BIBCO standard records 6

► 77 revised statements

LC-PCC PS Updates

April 2015

Focused on revisions prompted by the RDA revisions

- 46 revised statements
- ▶ 11 new statements
- 17 deleted statements

- Will not include changes to 1XX fields
- Major tasks
 - To re-code AACR2 authority records as RDA when 1XX fields contain no RDA-contrary elements
 - To add 024 fields for ISNIs to names in the LC/NAF that match the OCLC-Leiden supplied list of ISNIs

► May occur on records already coded as RDA

Will also

Replace obsolete indicators in 1XX, 4XX and 5XX fields with blanks

- Adjust Leader/17 (encoding level)
- Adjust 008/39 (cataloging source) to remove obsolete data
- Supply qualifiers for initialisms and acronyms in 410 fields, when possible

Will also

- Evaluate contents of 370 field for compliance with LC/NAF, LCSH, etc.
- Generate 046 field from \$d or 670 for personal names
- Formulate 046s with hyphens and add \$2 edtf

MARC Authority Field 046

Extended Date and Time Format (EDTF)

- Adopted after discussions on PCClist and deliberations in LC's Network Development and MARC Standards Office and the Phase 3 Task Group
- To provide greater efficiency for catalogers, who will not have to remember when to use hyphens and \$2

MARC Authority Field 046

Examples of EDTF format

MARC Authority Field 046

- Documentation on EDTF in DCM Z1 and LC-PCC PSs will be updated
 - Catalogers should wait for the revisions before using the new EDTF formulation

MARC Authority Field 046

Subfields \$s and \$t have been redefined, and \$q and \$r have been added

- Continue to use the old definitions until the new values are implemented
- LC must give the green light first
 - Works with the NACO-nodes and announces a start date

MARC Authority Field 046

LC has a back-burner project to programmatically revise data from \$s and \$t to \$q and \$r

► To occur after Phase 3B

- In authority records for LCSH, CSH, LCGFT, and LCMPT
 - ► New coding for "replacement" LCCN
 - ► SHM H 193.5 has been revised

Romance literature; Love stories

Romance fiction: fiction in Romance languages, treated collectively

Love stories: fiction about romantic love

Romance literature; Love stories

May 2015

- Romance literature revised to Romancelanguage literature
- Narrower terms also revised (e.g., Epic poetry, Romance-language)
- Earlier-form-of heading UF references provided

Romance literature; Love stories

No earlier than September 2015

- Love stories will be revised to Romance fiction
- Love stories qualified by a nationality or language will also be revised
- Earlier-form-of-heading UF reference Romance fiction will be removed from Romance-language fiction

Romance literature; Love stories

New form of heading for Love stories will match old heading Romance fiction

- Careful database maintenance will be necessary to avoid confusion
 - PSD suggests that the bib records containing Romance fiction be revised before the revision to Love stories occurs

Genre/Form Projects



- Approved 567 terms in February 2015
- PSD and MLA's project participants are still discussing approximately 100 terms
 - Will appear on Tentative Lists as the issues are resolved

Genre/Form Projects

Literature

- Approved approximately 230 terms in May 2015
- Review of remaining terms postponed due to staffing and workload considerations in PSD

► Will be approved in September 2015

- PSD is not accepting proposals for new and revised genre/form terms in the following areas
 - "General" terms
 - Music
 - Literature
 - Religion

Demographic Group Terms

- Intended to be used to describe the characteristics of
 - The creators of, and contributors to, resources, when their characteristics are explicitly stated
 - The intended audience, when explicitly stated or otherwise obvious

Demographic Group Terms

LCDGT pilot

- Approved approximately 400 terms in June 2015
- Introduction and guiding principles for the pilot

Demographic Group Terms

LCDGT Pilot, Phase 2

- PSD policy specialists will make proposals to enhance scope and coverage
- Proposals will be approved by end of 2015

Demographic Group Terms

Recommendation

- Wait until Phase 2 is complete before attempting to implement the terms
 - Vocabulary is not yet robust enough to support general use
