The Sears List of Subject Headings continues to be updated under the guidance of the List's Editor, Barbara Bristow, and a team of librarians at EBSCO Information Services. All additions and revisions will be updated in the Sears EBSCOhost database at the end of the year. **Sears headings are now available to our electronic users as MARC authority files, for an additional fee.** In addition, all headings are RDA compliant.
