

Our community is organized into two steering committees and will launch several to many short-term task forces.

The Program Steering Committee will take the lead in developing programming for our Community. The Member Experience Steering focuses on all other of the Community, including assessing our Community effectiveness and on networking.

Steering Committees may form Task Forces to further develop an idea (or may have a strong conception already), and will form Task Forces to implement programs and events.

Our Task Forces will provide participants frequent, shorter-term and more focused opportunities to make an impact within assessment--disbanding when work is completed, likely after 3-6 months. The rolling nature of these opportunities may mean that the right opportunities are available for participants when we are each most available to engage with what matters to us.
