*Hello SustainRT Community. We are very excited to share that we have partnered with ALA's Social Responsibility Round Table as well as the Asian Pacific American Librarians Association and the American Indian Library Association to bring Bill McKibben, author, environmentalist, and activist to ALA Annual 2017! Bill McKibben was awarded the Right Livelihood Prize in 2014, which is sometimes called the “alternative Nobel.” McKibben is also a co-founder and Senior Advisor at 350.org, an international, grassroots climate movement that works in 188 countries around the world to organize rallies and spearhead resistance to the Keystone Pipeline. This organization is also credited with beginning the fossil fuel divestment movement. To honor Bill's dedication, biologists named a new species of woodland gnat (*Megophthalmidia mckibbeni*) after him in 2014. We are also honored that he will be joining us at ALA Annual 2017 in Chicago. Please look for details in the near future.*
